(Romans 5: 8-11) Jesus also set the example of conduct for those who want to please God. — John 13: 15.l

Next is I am . the truth." Jesus always spoke the truth, and he lived accordingly. (1 Peter 2:22) A person can learn about God by listening to Jesus. (John 8:31, 32) Jesus is also "the truth" because he fulfilled Bible prophecy. Because of him, God's promises came true. — John 1:17; 2 Corinthians 1:19, 20; Colossians 2:16, 17.
